WHAT DOES ELLIOTT COMMUNITY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

WHY?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal Law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal Law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

Elliott Community Federal Credit Union collects nonpublic personal information directly from members, join owners, co-borrowers, and from many sources. This includes:

- Information we receive from you on applications with us
- Information we receive from a consumer reporting agency.
- Information obtained when verifying the information, you provide on an application or other forms; this may be obtained from your current or past employers, or from other institutions where you conduct financial transactions.

We may disclose all of the information we collect, as described above, as permitted by law.

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Elliott Community Federal Credit Union chooses to share. And whether you can limit this sharing.
